As part of the examination preparation and performance, students (other than piano) will require an accompanist. Rehearsal time with the accompanist will vary depending upon the individual student's needs. If students are well prepared, we would expect them to require approximately 2 – 3 rehearsal sessions. Please note that the rehearsal time included in the accompaniment fees (see the below table) allows for 2 rehearsals. The fee for the accompanist for extra rehearsals is \$36.80 per ½ hour session. Depending on repertoire and the individual student, extra rehearsals may be required. The music department will contact you if your child's instrumental teacher or accompanist feels more rehearsals are necessary. The minimum charge is summarised below:

The accompaniment fees will also cover any accompaniment for solo performances at College Music Evenings and other performances where students are representing the College.

In addition, there may be a travel levy charged for those students who are completing a metropolitan examination (in Melbourne). The travel levy amount will depend on how many students the pianist will be accompanying on a particular day and will be determined on an individual basis.
